while Carmeuse Lime Products Ghana Limited was also adjudged first runner up for Best Performer in Local Manufacturing of Mining Inputs.

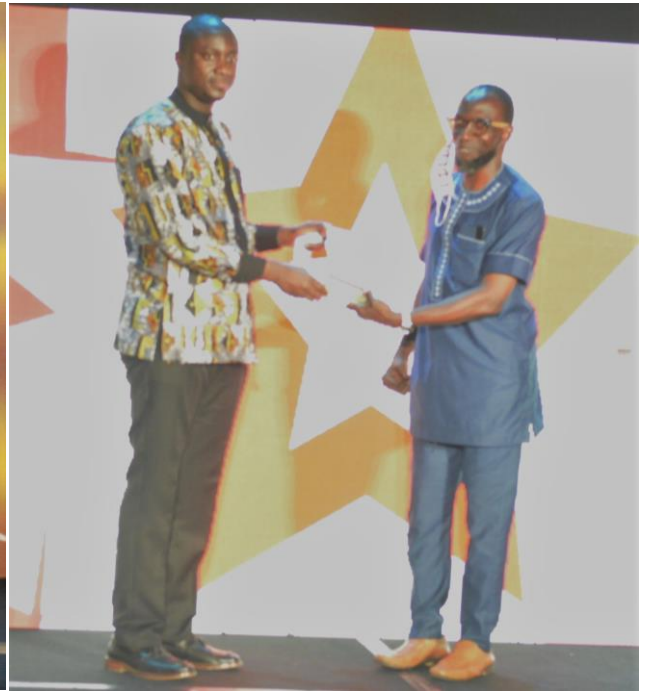
