Fireside Event Inspires Dialogue on Resilience, Leadership and Empowerment

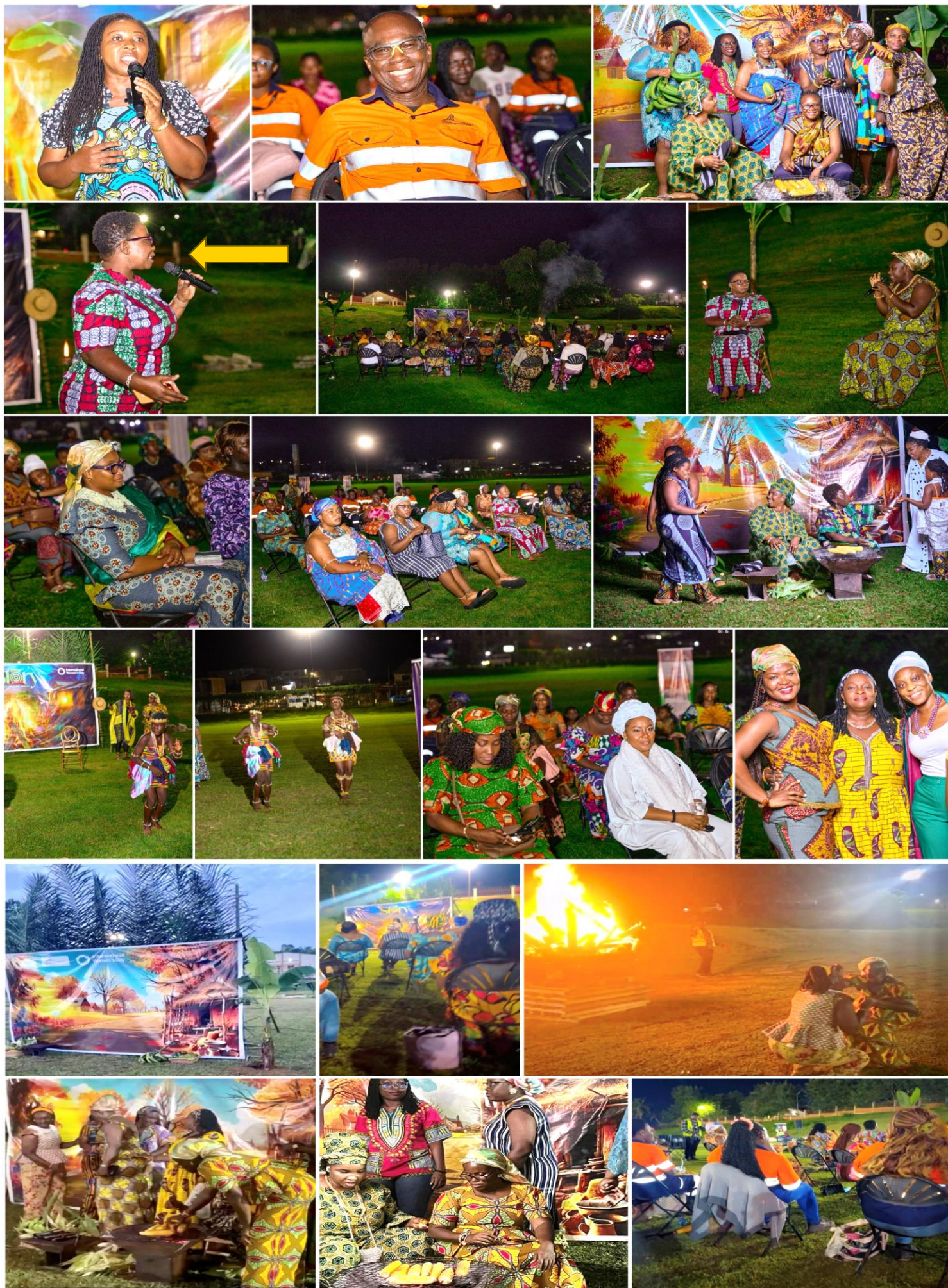
